

Online game incident reports. These are not an option, they are required to be completed WITHIN 24 hours of the incident. No questions asked. With the holiday season here Canada Post is back logged and we cannot rely on the game sheets making it to the appropriate person on time. That is why these have to be completed as soon as possible.

When filling out the reports, remember to select the appropriate league. If it is an ODWHA game select ODWHA as the league, that way the appropriate group gets the report online. Also, when specifying the penalty and the rule being called, be sure to write the exact penalty and rule. When you just put GM that doesn't help us as there are numerous Game Misconduct penalties. Same with rules, don't just put rule 47, specify the option A, B etc...as they all have different consequences.

If you have any issues with filling the report, whether you don't know how to fill it out, need help with rules, or when you submit it and get an error, or even after you submit it and don't get the notice in an email shortly after, please don't hesitate to contact me.

I cannot iterate enough as to how important these reports are, and that they have to be taken seriously.

Please also note that you are to keep the white copy of the game sheet and mail it in to the appropriate association, after receiving the envelope from the offending team. If you the offending team does not supply an envelope, then please mail it yourself and let the RIC know as she will follow up with the appropriate association to ensure that they provide these as they are supposed to.

For tournaments we do not complete game incident reports online, they must be done right after the game at the tournament venue.
